# Continental quotas

2 Girls Teams Africa: 2 Boys Teams Asia: 3 Boys Teams 3 Girls Teams 3 Boys Teams 3 Girls Teams Europe: Pan America: 3 Boys Teams 3 Girls Teams Oceania: 1 Boys Team 1 Girls Team

Important Information: In case the respective Continental Event is not completed before 27th September 2020 or two months before the WJTTC, the above quotas will be filled based on the latest available ITTF U18 World Team Ranking, at the month the invitations are sent out (i.e. October 2020 if the WJTTC can take place on the dates originally scheduled).

The Continental Quotas take precedence over the WR quotas.

#### WR quota

3 Top Teams WR: 3 Boys Teams 3 Girls Teams

In addition to these 15 teams, the Host Association (Portugal) is entitled to one team in each of the Boys and Girls Team events.

## **INDIVIDUAL EVENTS**

### Boys and Girls Singles

Up to 80 boys and 80 girls may enter the singles with a maximum of 4 boys and 4 girls per association.

The positions for the Singles events will be distributed as follows:

- 16 Associations qualified for the team events by 4 athletes 64
- ITTF U18 World Singles Ranking\* 16

## **Boys and Girls Doubles**

Up to 40 pairs of boys and girls may enter the doubles with a maximum of 2 boys pairs and 2 girls pairs per Association. These 40 pairs will be composed of the players entered for the teams and singles events.

In boys and girls doubles events both players of a pair shall be from the same Association.

### **Mixed Doubles**

Up to 80 mixed pairs may enter the Mixed Doubles. They will be selected out of the players entered for the teams and singles events.

Associations may form a mixed doubles pair consisting of players from different Associations.

**Important Information**: Each Association may enter a maximum of 4 players (if entitled by team selection or ranking selection in singles) but it is not permitted to enter different players in the team event and in the individual events.

**Note**: In case the WJTTC 2020 is postponed due to Covid-19 or has to take place with certain restricting measures, then the qualification system is subject to further changes.
